THE PENSION GOVERNANCE BOARD EDUCATION COMMITTEE

Terms of Reference

NAME: This Committee shall be called the Pension Governance Board (PGB)

Education Committee

STATUS: The PGB Education Committee operates as a committee of the Pension

> Governance Board under the authority of the Delegation Document Regarding Governance of the Pension Plan and of the Registered

Retirement Savings Plan, Section 1.2.

MANDATE: To discuss and act upon any educational or communications matter

related to the Pension Plan and make appropriate recommendations to

the PGB.

The Committee shall consist of at least four (4) voting persons appointed MEMBERSHIP: by the PGB annually:

Appointed members

The members of the Committee must be members of the PGB.

The Chair shall be selected from among the members of the Committee.

At least one of the members of the Committee shall be an employee group-appointed representative.

At least one of the members of the Committee shall be a Boardappointed representative.

Standing members

The Director of Human Resources shall be a voting member.

Resources

The HR Consultant responsible for pension administration:

The HR Assistant as Recording Secretary.

MEETINGS: The Committee shall meet at least four (4) times per year in advance of

scheduled PGB meetings.

A majority of the total voting membership, including one employee group-QUORUM:

appointed representative, shall constitute a quorum.

FUNCTIONS: It is the function of the Committee to develop and recommend to the

PGB an education program for Plan members regarding pension issues.

The following are functions that fall within this mandate:

1. Develop and recommend to PGB annually an education program and communications plan for Plan members;

2. Implement annually the PGB approved education program and

communications plan;

3. Organize annually at least one open information session for all

Plan members on investment performance;

4. Monitor pension legislation regulations, where applicable, to inform the Committee's decision making;

5. Review annually the Committee's Terms of Reference.

REPORTING: The Committee shall provide an annual report to the PGB. The

> Committee will maintain minutes of their meetings and circulate a copy to the PGB. The Committee will periodically provide recommendations to the PGB with respect to education and/or communications to Plan

members.
