Dear MSVUFA members,

I'm writing to bring the recent updates on CA and Labour Board Complaints.

On December 3, as per the Labour Board facilitated discussion agreement, the MSVUFA sent to MSVU President Dickinson two letters appended to the Collective Agreement: Letter 1 – Appendix B, and Letter 2 – Additional Salary Steps. The two letters are posted on the FA website under [Resources](#). I'm also attaching them to this email for your convenience.

On December 4, the Canadian Association of University Teachers (CAUT) Executive, on behalf of 72,000 faculty across Canada, sent a formal letter to the MSVU President Dickinson notifying the CAUT Council's unanimous resolution passed on November 30, urging President Dickinson to ensure there is no repeat of delay in signing a Collective Agreement in the future.

On December 4, the Association of Nova Scotia University Teachers (ANSUT) Council passed a motion similar to the CAUT Council resolution. The ANSUT represents over 1,200 full-and part-time university teachers across Nova Scotia. On December 5, the ANSUT Executive issued a formal letter to the MSVU Board of Governors to notify the motion. In their letter the ANSUT Executive expressed their concern and dismay at the Employer's delay tactics in signing the CA and reiterated their solidarity with the MSVUFA.

On December 10, the Nova Scotia Labour Board issued two orders regarding the Employer's Complaint and the MSVUFA's Complaint, respectively, announcing that both parties have withdrawn their complaints. The two orders are posted on the NS Labour Board website under [Decisions](#). I'm also attaching them to this email for your convenience.
